

Court Etiquette

Correct tennis shoes must be worn on the courts. Black soled or ridged shoes are not permitted.

Appropriate sports clothing should be worn on court and shirts should not be removed.

Members must not walk behind a court whilst play is in progress.

Mobile phones should be switched off.

No food or chewing gum is allowed on court.

Nets should be wound down at the end of play.

Floodlights must be switched off at times agreed with Bathurst estate. Please see the website for details.

Smoking and Vaping is not allowed on the club courts or premises.

Official matches have priority over all other activities except during club sessions and pre-allocated coaching sessions.

The courts are for the use of all members at all times and block bookings of all the floodlit courts at the same time must therefore only be done with the prior approval of the committee.

Juniors have equal playing status on courts until 6pm, when they must give way to adults.

Juniors of an adequate standard may be allowed to play at Club sessions at the discretion of the committee.

The last person leaving the Club must ensure that it is securely locked.

After play, all litter should be removed and the Club must be left in a tidy condition.

No dogs, bikes or skateboards etc. allowed on court.

No visitor may play more than three times in any one year.

The Club shall not be responsible or liable in respect of personal injury to any member, or loss or damage to the property of any member, whether or not due to negligence of the members of the Club or its officers.
