### Winter Leagues

As I commented at our last AGM, it was very disappointing that we only entered one ladies team in 2021, having to withdraw the mens prior to playing the first match due to a poor response and availability problems

The ladies, organised by Mary Merricks, for which we appreciated, did suffer from some availability issues despite registering 13 players and finishing fourth in Division 1 and being relegated
